Timothy N. Pfeiffer, being duly sworn, deposes and says:

I am a member of the firm of Milbank, Tweed and Hope, attorneys for the defendants, The Associated Press, et al., in the above-entitled case, and am admitted to practice in this Court. I am familiar with the proceedings heretofore had herein and, together with numerous legal associates and with employees of The Associated Press, have been engaged in making studies of the records of The Associated Press.

As appears from its records, The Associated Press, shortly after its incorporation in 1900 under the Membership Laws of the State of New York, had between 600 and 700 members. Since that time there have been 1890 additions to the membership, as shown by the printed annual reports of The Associated Press, copies of which are in the possession of the plaintiff. Exhibit A, annexed hereto, is a tabulation from the printed annual reports showing the number of applicants elected each year from 1901-1942, inclusive.

The printed annual reports also show that during the same period at least 21 members were expelled.

The records of The Associated Press also show that the number of present members who were elected to membership following waivers of rights of protest is at least 200. No check has been made of the number of members throughout the period who were elected following waivers of rights of protest, but who have resigned and are not now members.

Annexed hereto and marked Exhibit B is a list of 496 cities in the United States having daily newspapers, none of which were members of The Associated Press, as of September 30, 1941, together with city population, name of paper, morning or evening, circulation and news service subscribed to. This list was compiled from information contained in Editor & Publisher International Year Book [fol. 2340] 1942 as corrected by reference to the list of As-

AFFIDAVIT OF ALFRED McCLUNG LEE

STATE OF NEW YORK,
County of New York, ss:

Alfred McClung Lee, being duly sworn, deposes and says:

I have heretofore executed three affidavits on May 10, May 20, and May 22, 1943, respectively. I am informed that on May 25, 1943, these affidavits were filed by the plaintiff in the case of *United States v. The Associated Press*, Civil Action No. 19-163, now pending in the United States District Court for the Southern District of New York, in support of its motion for summary judgment. These affidavits have since been printed in a document which bears the title of said case and the further heading or designation, "Affidavits Filed in Support of Plaintiff's Motion for Summary Judgment". Attached to my affidavits of May 10, 1943, and May 22, 1943, were various exhibits containing statistical data computed by me and these exhibits, as printed in the document previously mentioned, cover more than 80 printed pages.

[fol. 2416] I have read an affidavit executed by Harold L. Cross on June 17, 1943, which affidavit, as I am informed, is one of a series of affidavits filed by the defendants in the *Associated Press* case on June 21, 1943. The affidavit of Mr. Cross undertakes to belittle the significance of some of the data shown by the exhibits attached to my affidavits of May 10, 1943, and May 22, 1943, but points to only one factual error therein. This involved the computation in Exhibit No. 7, attached to my affidavit of May 10, 1943, of the total population of the 25 largest cities of the country for the year 1900, 1910, 1920, 1930, and 1940, and the error in question was an understatement of the population total in each of these years by exactly 10,000,000, with a resulting error in the computation of the 1930 and 1940 population index numbers (based on 1920) for the total population of the 25 largest cities.

The computations appearing in the exhibits attached to my affidavits were carefully prepared and checked. The 10,000,000 error in the population totals in Exhibit No. 7 undoubtedly grew out of the fact that the tabulating machine used in computing the totals appearing in this exhibit did not record the figure carried forward when the addition exceeded 9,999,999, and by an inadvertent failure to make correctly, with respect to the population totals, the adjustment required by the mechanical limitation in the capacity of the tabulating machine.

With reference to the only error in the exhibits attached to my affidavits which has been called to my attention I desire to point out the following:

(1) The error as to population totals in Exhibit No. 7 (including index numbers for population) does not in any way affect the significance or accuracy of the other data (including index numbers) in that exhibit.

(2) I did not regard the population figures as of sufficient significance to warrant any reference to them in that portion of my affidavit of May 10, 1943, which discusses [fol. 2417] facts shown by Exhibit No. 7 and I am informed that the Government, in two briefs which it filed in the *Associated Press* case before it was aware of any error in population figures, made several references to the data contained in Exhibit No. 7 but made no reference, direct or indirect, to the figures or index numbers for population.

(3) The error in Exhibit No. 7 as to population totals involved five figures and two index numbers in an exhibit containing over 1350 separate figures or index numbers.

(4) The defendants in the *Associated Press* case have pointed out no other error in the many thousands of figures and other like data included in the exhibits attached to my affidavits of May 10, 1943, and May 22, 1943.

EXHIBIT C

Declaration of Trust

with respect to

The Employees' Benefit Fund

Know all men by these presents:

That, whereas, The Associated Press, a membership corporation, organized and existing under and by virtue [fol. 2421] of the laws of the State of New York, hereinafter referred to as the "Corporation", heretofore, and in or about the year 1918 created a plan, for the benefit of its employees, known and designated as "The Employees' Vacation, Pension, Disability Benefit and Death Benefit Plan"; and

Whereas, pursuant to and in accordance with the aforesaid plan, the Corporation has created and maintained a fund for the payment of pensions and benefits thereunder, which fund is known and designated as "the Employees' Benefit Fund"; and

Whereas, The Employees' Benefit Fund is invested in the securities listed on the Schedule annexed to and made

a part of this instrument and marked Schedule "A"; and

Whereas, it has been necessary and advisable to make certain changes in the administration of The Employees' Benefit Fund, which changes are outlined in the "Pension Plan—Revision of 1938"; approved by the Board of Directors of the Corporation on October 5, 1938;

Now, Therefore, in consideration of the premises, and to effectuate better the purposes of the aforesaid Plan, the Corporation shall and hereby does establish, set aside and declare The Employees' Benefit Fund, to be an irrevocable trust for the uses and purposes herein set forth, to wit:

First: The principal and income or profits from The Employees' Benefit Fund shall constitute a fund for the payment of pensions to employes of the Corporation who, at retiring age, shall have completed, at least, one year's continuous employment by the Corporation on or before December 31, 1938. Pensions to be paid out of such fund shall be in the amount stated, upon the terms and conditions set forth, and forth periods of service designated in the "Pension Plan—Revision of 1938", a copy of which is annexed to and made a part hereof.

[fol. 2422] Second: The Corporation shall hold and invest and reinvest The Employees' Benefit Fund and the income and profits thereof, in such securities as the Board of Directors of the Corporation may, from time to time deem advisable. After paying or providing for the payment of any and all expenses or other lawful charges in connection with the administration thereof, The Employees' Benefit Fund, and the income and profits thereof, shall be used and applied exclusively for the purposes herein set forth.

Third: The Employees' Benefit Fund shall, at all times, be held separate and apart from the general assets of the Corporation and shall not be commingled with such assets. The Corporation shall keep separate books of account for The Employees' Benefit Fund and in all financial statements, either public or private, in which The Employees' Benefit Fund shall be listed, it shall clearly appear that such fund is not part of the general assets of the Corporation.

Fourth: The Corporation shall have the right to make such changes in or amendments to the terms and conditions of the Plan governing the payment of pensions to employes

as therein provided, but no changes or amendments shall be made with respect to such Plan or the terms and conditions thereof which are inconsistent with or contrary to the provisions of this Declaration of Trust.

Fifth: If, after all of the obligations of the Corporation under the "Pension Plan—Revision of 1938", and under the terms of this instrument have been provided for, any balance shall remain in the said fund, such balance may, in the discretion of the Board of Directors of the Corporation, be used by the Corporation for either or both of the following purposes:

1. As a contribution to or to pay either the primary or periodic expense of any other fund then existing or which [fol. 2423] may thereafter be established or maintained by the Corporation, either directly or indirectly, or by any Federal, State or Municipal government or governmental agency, to provide for the payment of pensions to employes of the Corporation, irrespective of the time an employe's service begins with the Corporation.

2. As a contribution by the Corporation to any then existing plan or project for the benefit of the employes of the Corporation or as an allowance or bonus or honorarium for any employe or employes, or the dependents of any deceased employe of the Corporation, which the Board of Directors of the Corporation may designate.

Sixth: The Corporation shall have the right, at any time, to terminate its trusteeship of the trust established hereunder, and to transfer to and vest the administration of the trust in such trustee or trustees as the Board of Directors of the Corporation may designate. Such successor trustee or trustees shall have the same rights and obligations with respect to The Employes' Benefit Fund as are reserved to and assumed by the Corporation under this instrument.

Seventh: The Corporation shall have the right to liquidate The Employes' Benefit Fund whenever in the judgment of the Board of Directors of the Corporation it becomes advisable to do so. Upon such liquidation, the fund shall be used either to purchase pension insurance benefits for the employes entitled thereto in the amounts stated, upon the terms and conditions set forth, and for

the periods of service designated in the Pension Plan—Revision of 1938, or if the purchase of pension insurance benefits shall be deemed to be impractical by the Board of Directors of the Corporation, The Employes' Benefit Fund shall be distributed to such employes, the distributive share of each employe to be determined in accordance with the [fol. 2424] provisions of the Pension Plan—Revision of 1938 and standard actuarial tables.

If The Employes' Benefit Fund is used either to purchase pension insurance benefits or is distributed to the employes entitled thereto, as herein provided, the Corporation shall be discharged from all liability under the Pension Plan—Revision of 1938, and this instrument.

Eighth: This Declaration of Trust shall not, in any manner, limit any liability which is now or may be hereafter imposed by law upon the Corporation.

This Declaration of Trust is executed by the Corporation pursuant to authority of a resolution of its Board of Directors adopted at a meeting thereof, held at the offices of the Corporation in New York, N. Y., on the 5th day of October, 1938.

In witness whereof, the Corporation has cause these presents to be signed by its President and its corporate seal to be hereunto affixed and attested by its Secretary, the 7th day of October, 1938.

TO THE EMPLOYEES:

The Board of Directors at its meeting last week adopted a revision of The Associated Press "Employees' Vacation, Pension, Disability Benefit and Death Benefit Plan" which was the definition of the plan adopted first in 1918. En-[fol. 2426] closed is a copy of the plan affecting the fund created during the last 20 years. It is entitled "Revision of 1938", and is effective January 1, 1939.

The Board of Directors at the same meeting approved a proposal of a participating pension plan and also a participating insurance plan, the former taking into account the expense of and the expected payments under the United States government Social Security Act affecting old age benefits.

The insurance plan which is a proposed revision of the present Associated Press insurance plan is more liberal than has been possible in the past. The basis of both the pension and insurance plans is optional but three-fourths of the employees must participate in order to make each effective.

The above is all in pursuance of the statement I made early last year to the effect that a change in the employees' Benefit Plan obviously would have to be made and that study was being given to it. With the increasing taxes imposed by the government in connection with Social Security in conformity with government laws it is necessary to arrange future pension and insurance plans in The Associated Press with employe cooperation.

However, this communication is intended only to present the booklet on the revision of 1938 of the Employees' Benefit Plan as affects pensions. Later communications will outline the proposed pension plan and the proposed insurance plan.

If after thoroughly studying the enclosed booklet there are any questions to be asked I will appreciate it if the

Revision of 1938

Effective January 1, 1939

Foreword

The Associated Press in 1918 created a plan known as the "Employes' Vacation, Pension, Disability Benefit and Death Benefit Plan".

When the fund which was established to make the plan effective was created by the Board of Directors of The Associated Press in 1918 it was named "The Employes' Benefit Fund".

The action at that time constituted a pioneer effort of the kind of employe-employer relations. For that reason it was then understood that while the conditions and regulations were and are subject to amendment, The Associated Press would endeavor to carry on the plan as originally announced, with only decennial revisions or amendments. The conditions and regulations were not altered at all until 1928 except that in the matter of insurance the voluntary grant was increased.

With the United States government having, effective January 1, 1937, itself established an old age pension plan at the expense of the employer and the employe, it was obvious that the conditions and regulations of this fund would have to be revised. Announcement was made last year that the matter was under consideration. It was decided to wait until the end of the second decennial period (1938) to announce any changes.

[fol. 2428] Earnest study of the conflicting situation has brought what apparently is the only possible conclusion, namely the necessity of no liabilities being permitted to accrue against the Employes' Benefit Fund after December

31 next. This action it is hoped will conserve the fund so that it can properly and adequately fulfill the pension grants for service accrued prior to that date. Another plan having no connection whatever with this one may be presented to be effective January 1, 1939, but the outline given herein shall be confined to a statement of the revision of the 1918 plan which was last revised in 1928. This revision shall be known as that of 1938.

The conditions and regulations originally included pension, life insurance and disability grants. Later vacation grants were incorporated. Under the revision now effective the expense of disability and vacation grants becomes a part of the general expenses of The Associated Press. The Employees' Benefit Fund will not be involved because of them. Life insurance may later be undertaken under another plan which will constitute the "Insurance Plan". This means that unless the Board finds it practical to include other benefits the existing Employees' Benefit Fund will be used solely for the payment of pensions in conformity with the revised Pension Plan herein outlined.

The Employees' Benefit Fund

(1) For the establishment of the fund The Associated Press has contributed variable amounts. The Board of Directors of The Associated Press shall decide as time goes on whether it is expedient for additional amounts to be appropriated in order to maintain the fund so that it can meet the grants herein mentioned. No contractual obligation to make such contributions to the fund, however, is assumed by The Associated Press.

(2) The fund itself shall be conserved for the employes under a trust indenture prepared in conformity with the [fol. 2429] law and shall be invested in such securities as the Board of Directors of The Associated Press may deem advisable, all income and profits from the investments to become a part of the fund. However, the Board of Directors of The Associated Press may cause the fund to be paid over to one or more insurance companies under an arrangement whereby the pension benefits specified in the pension plan would be paid directly to the beneficiaries by the insurance companies instead of by The Associated Press. Until such time as all pension obligations of those entitled thereto have been provided for, the fund can only be dis-

bursed under strict trusteeship for the benefit of employes of The Associated Press.

(3) A report showing the condition of the fund and the receipts and disbursements will be made available to employes from time to time.

Definitions

In these regulations:

(1) "The Board" shall mean the Board of Directors of The Associated Press.

(2) The word "employee" or "employes" shall mean those persons who receive a regular and stated compensation from The Associated Press, other than a pension and who do not have any other employer and whose assignments are not of a transitory character.

(3) "Fund" shall mean the Employees' Benefit Fund.

(4) The expression "term of employment" shall mean continuous employment in the service of The Associated Press.

(5) The word "plan" shall mean this pension plan as herein detailed or later amended by the Board.

[fol. 2430] (6) The term "employment" means any service performed by the employe for The Associated Press for which the employe is remunerated by The Associated Press.

(7) The word "trustee" shall mean the trustee of the Employees' Benefit Fund.

The Pension Plan

The Associated Press pension plan which was established as a part of the Employees' Benefit Plan in 1918 is administered in accordance with, and subject to, the conditions and regulations fixed by the Board of Directors of The Associated Press. The conditions and regulations, specified herein and hereafter called the plan, constitute the policy applicable to the distribution of the fund. The plan is subject to amendment by the Board, for either of the following two purposes.

1. To meet the expense of other pension benefits for employes if it is found the status of the fund will permit

after adequate provision has been made for the pension allowances payable under this plan, or,

2. To decrease the amount of pension allowances granted thereafter if it is found the status of the fund so requires.

Compulsory Retirement

Upon attaining the age of 65 years the employment of any male individual, or upon attaining the age of 55 years the employment of any female individual shall automatically terminate but such individual shall receive a pension if his or her term of employment qualifies him or her to receive a pension in accordance with the provisions of the plan. The ages of 65 for males and 55 for females shall in this plan be known as the normal retiring age.

[fol. 2431] Pension Allowances

Pension allowances payable at retiring age shall be the amounts that result from the following computation:

(1) The annual pension allowance payable, at normal retirement age, shall be 2% of the employe's average annual salary during his period of employment by The Associated Press in the decade 1929-1938, multiplied by the number of his or her years of continuous employment by The Associated Press (not exceeding 25 years) prior to January 1, 1939.

(2) None of the years of the employe's term of employment after December 31, 1938, shall be included in computing any pension allowance under this plan; but continuous employment after December 31, 1938, up to normal or optional retirement age is required to make the employe eligible to receive a pension allowance at such age. Termination of employment before normal retiring age cancels the right to receive a pension allowance except as provided under "optional retirements".

(3) If the employe shall not have completed at least one full year of continuous employment on December 31, 1938, he shall not be eligible to any pension allowance under this plan.

(4) No pension shall at any time be granted in excess of 50% of the average annual salary for the years of service (not exceeding 10 years) next preceding January 1, 1939.

(5) Pension allowances shall be paid in equal monthly installments from date of retirement to death of pensioner.

Optional Retirement

Any employe whose term of employment totals 15 years and who, if a male, has attained the age of 50 years, or, if a [fol. 2432] female, has attained the age of 40 years, may at his or her option, be retired and granted a pension which shall be a percentage of that to which the employe would be entitled at 65 years of age, if a male, and at 55 years of age, if a female, as follows:

General Provisions

(1) Neither the action of the Board of Directors in establishing this plan nor any action hereinafter taken by the Board thereunder shall be construed as giving to any officer, agent, or employe of The Associated Press the right to be retained in its service nor any right nor claim to any pension allowance if employment is discontinued, since all rights accruing under this plan terminate upon severance of employment.

(2) In case any benefit or pension for the employe's term of employment (such as additions to or in amendment of the United States government benefits for the calendar years 1937-1938 or any other of the years of employment

[fol. 2433] prior thereto upon which a pension allowance payable hereunder shall be computed), shall be payable under the laws now in force or hereafter enacted by any State or Country to an individual entitled to a pension hereunder in conformity with such laws, the annual pension payable under these regulations shall be reduced the annual equivalent of such benefit or pension prescribed by law. A payment made to a retired employe by or under the authority of the laws of any State or Country shall be deemed to be a pension payable under the laws of such State or Country within the meaning of this paragraph, whether the payment shall be made direct by The Associated Press or out of a fund under the custody and control of the State or Country or a commission thereof to which the employe as well as The Associated Press may have contributed.

(3) The right of any person to any future payment under this plan shall not be transferable or assignable, at law or in equity. If any employe or pensioner shall in any such manner encumber payments granted to him under this plan, all rights to future payments shall thereupon lapse and no further payments shall be made.

(4) Any tax imposed by any government authority on the Employes' Benefit Fund or upon its operations or upon the allowances paid from it shall, if ordered by such authority to be and thereupon is paid by The Associated Press, be deducted pro rata from the allowances paid to the pensioners hereunder and refunded to The Associated Press.

(5) Evidence of date of birth in such form as shall be satisfactory to the Board shall be furnished the Board before any pension allowance shall be paid.

(6) At the employer's request an employe at the employe's option may remain in service after normal retirement date, but during such period no pension shall be paid.
